Parts of Cell Memory Strategy & Moves

Say	Move
On the outside is the cell membrane which protects the cell	Hands pinch in a circle
On the inside is the nucleus which acts like a brain	Hands clasp together with fingers linked to look like brain and put beside head
Inside the nucleus is the nucleolus that has chromosomes, with DNA	Open hands to show linked fingers and wiggle
The ribosomes make proteins which are like chains	Use fingers to make chains
The endoplasmic reticulum transports stuff through the cell	Sweep from side to side
The Golgi apparatus packages materials into boxes, shoves it in the vacuole, slams the door and throw away the key	Use hands to make a box, pretend to shove box, slam door & throw away a key
Shake off that sticky cytoplasm	Shake hands up high
So you can be mighty like mighty mitochondria	Make muscles using arms
Cell wall, plants only	Make a large rectangle with hands
Chloroplasts contain chlorophyll	Dig ground
Which makes food so we can eat	Spoon food to mouth
